Please note: This plan of study assumes students will transfer to Illinois State with an Associates Degree. Total transfer hours applied to a degree program is 90 hours from a 4-year school or a combination of 2-year/4-year. Maximum from a 2-year school is 66 academic hours plus 4 hours PE activities. Students who have earned a baccalaureate-oriented associate degree from a regionally accredited institution in the United States will be considered to have met the General Education requirements.

Transfer students who will not have an Associates degree should meet with the English Department Advisor about an appropriate plan of study. The plan of study may be longer than two years.

*Foreign Language is determined by placement, students need to complete FL 115 to meet the BA requirement. Students are encouraged to complete their Foreign Language requirement prior to attending Illinois State University.

Students may need to take a Global Studies course, check with the English Department Advisor or on iCampus using the “progress towards degree” feature to see if the requirement has been met.

42 senior level hours are required for graduation. Courses from a Community College do not count towards Senior Hours. Students may need to take additional 200 and 300 level courses to complete the graduation requirement. At most, the English major will provide 37 senior hours.

A minor is strongly encouraged and may be used in place of non major electives.
